NYLT Scholarship Application

About the Scholarships:

The NYLT Scholarship fund was established to help assist Scouts who would like to attend the NYLT Course in Jayhawk Area Council. NYLT is an extremely valuable opportunity to gain leadership experience that Scouts can use in both Scouting and their personal lives. Funds for these scholarships come from the Wood Badge and NYLT Annual Banquet as well as direct contributions from Jayhawk Area Council Scouters.

Each year there are limited funds available so the NYLT Scholarship Committee asks that applications for scholarships be for Scouts with true financial need. **The maximum amount a scholarship will cover is 50% of the total Early Bird Registration Fee.** The committee will do everything they can to make sure every Scout has an equal opportunity to attend NYLT.

Applying for Scholarships:

If a Scout has tried to raise funds to attend NYLT and still needs financial assistance, they can complete the application process detailed below.

- 1. The Scout's Parents and Unit Leaders should have a conversation establish a need for an NYLT Scholarship. Make sure all other sources of funding have been exhausted before requesting a Scholarship.
- 2. Register and pay the minimum \$20 non-refundable down payment to reserve the Scout's spot for the course. **This must be done prior to applying for an NYLT Scholarship**. Registration information can be found at <u>www.jayhawkcouncil.org/training/nylt</u>
- 3. The Scout, Parent/Guardian, and Unit Leader must fill out the NYLT Scholarship Application (next page). The comments on each application will be treated as confidential and only members of the NYLT Scholarship Committee will have access to this information. The application must be filled out completely and signed by the Scout, Parent/Guardian, and Unit Leader. Incomplete applications will not be processed.
- Signed Applications must be submitted to the NYLT Scholarship Committee and/or Jayhawk Area Council Office no later than April 1st.
- 5. Applicants will be notified by April 15th of how much Scholarship they are awarded and applied towards their registration.
