TRUSTWORTHY – I will arrive at all classes and scheduled programming on time. I will tell the full truth in all situations. I will respect the privacy of others. I will return any unattended items to their owner or give them to a member of the staff to put in the lost and found. I will respect all equipment and property given to me.

LOYAL – I will support my youth leadership and adult leadership. I will wear the proper uniform when asked, as a sign of loyalty to Scouting and my fellow youth.

HELPFUL – I will demonstrate that I care about others through my words, actions, and deeds. I will readily and gladly volunteer to help others without expectation of a reward.

FRIENDLY – Everyone has the right to live and study in an environment free from discrimination or harassment based on race, color, ethnicity, religion, gender, sexual orientation, age, disability, national origin, or citizenship, so I will be friendly and welcoming to all.

COURTEOUS – I will treat others with courtesy. I will respect my fellow Scouts and the youth and adult leadership of NYLT. I will treat the wildlife in the camp with respect by leaving them alone. I will not kill animals or insects*. I will not cut down plants without reason. I will mind my manners at all times.

KIND – I will treat other people and their property as I would like to be treated. I will be kind to all of nature's creatures and to our environment.

OBEDIENT – I will politely and swiftly obey all appropriate requests made to me. I will especially obey all appropriate requests made by those in leadership roles and the requests of my Senior Patrol Leaders.

CHEERFUL – I will do my best to be enthusiastic in all situations.

THRIFTY – I will make the best use of food and other materials given to me.

BRAVE – I will do what is morally right, regardless of what anyone else may say.

CLEAN – I will keep our campsite and my personal gear clean. I will be clean in my speech, and I will not use foul language. I will not use alcohol, tobacco, etc. I will follow the principles of Leave No Trace.

REVERENT – I will respect the beliefs of others. I will fulfill my personal religious obligations through religious services afforded to me.

I understand that it is my responsibility to report instances of discrimination or harassment (directed at me, another participant, or staff member) to my NYLT Scoutmaster(s), NYLT Course Director, or any NYLT adult leader.
