The Jayhawk Area Council Bylaws has a limit to the number of executive board members and the committee weighs multiple factors when considering candidates.

Nominations must be received by January 15, 2025 to allow time for appropriate consideration. Nominations received after that date will be considered by the committee at a later meeting.

This individual must be present at the range during the range and target activity(s). Participating in this training will help ensure a unit understands Scouting America's range and target activities policies.

Keys to a successful Recharter is:

- Start early Get prepared!
- Identify a recharter champion.
 - Finish Membership inventory.
- Check YPT Aging Report.
- Create a plan to collect fees.

Avoid the common mistakes....

1. Missing Signature on Criminal Background Check Authorization Form. (Last Page Adult Application)

2. Missing/Expired Youth Protection Training. (Required for all over 18)

3. Missing Key 3 Approval.

4. Missing Adult Applications or incorrect fees collected. (See Fee Structure here.)

Remember..

Youth that has turned 18, will need YPT and Adult Application with Background Check Authorization.
