MEDICAL FORMS – All Scouts and leaders attending, whether camping or as a day visitor must have a current Annual Health and Medical Form parts A&B. Troop leadership is responsible for holding these forms during the Camporee. Troop Leadership shall address any limitations, medications, allergies or other medical issues relevant with the Scouts of their Troop. Please speak with Camp Leadership directly if there are any issues they need to be aware of.

VEHICLES AND TRAILERS – To protect our camp and our Scouts, only unit equipment trailers and vehicle pulling trailer will be allowed to be parked at campsites all others must be returned to the parking lot.

CHECK IN – The Troop's SPL (Senior Patrol Leader)/Crew or acting SPL and ONE adult leader per unit is to check in at the welcome center between 6:00 pm and 9:00 pm Units must provide a troop roster AND the cell phone number of at least one adult leader in charge. Units will be given their campsite assignment (if camping) and a schedule for the weekend upon check-in.

MEAL PLANNING – Units are responsible for all their meals. We highly recommend that meals be simple, and easy to prepare and clean up. This is a great opportunity for Scouts to work on their Cooking Merit Badge.

SANITATION, DRINKING WATER AND TRASH DISPOSAL – These will be conducted under Scouting standards as outlined in the Scout Handbook, Leave No Trace front country guidelines and other appropriate literature. Please consult with camp leadership for nearest facilities if you are unaware of Falley Scout Reservation.

RESPECT AND BEHAVIOR – Please respect the privacy of your neighboring units. Since you have other Scout units near your campsite, please keep the noise level down. Scouts and leaders are to behave as Scouts. The possession of or use of drugs, alcoholic beverages (including NA Beer), firearms, or fireworks is **STRICTLY PROHIBITED** and is not permitted in camp. Nighttime activities are at the Scoutmaster/SPL's discretion.

CHECK OUT – All Units must check out with camp leadership prior to departure on Sunday. Check out will not be permitted prior to closing ceremonies, unless extenuating circumstances appl. Camp leadership will inspect the campsite. Patches will be issued for the Camporee, one per participant. Patches will be distributed upon unit departure.

DUTCH OVEN COOK-OFF – All Scouts and Scouters are encouraged to participate in the cook-off. This is always a fun event that is limited only by your creativity.

Fishing Competition - Awards for Smallest Fish, Largest Fish, and most Caught

Shooting Sports - Shotgun, rifle, archery, and Cowboy Action shooting open. Additional fees apply. Fees can be paid at camp.

Disc Golf Competition: Awards for longest put, longest drive, and closest to pin from tee box

Closing ceremony - At the end of all events Saturday we will meet at Inspiration Point for our awards ceremony and campfire
