KEY SAFETY MOMENTS FOR HALLOWEEN

Safe Travel:

- Always use sidewalks and crosswalks when possible.
- Walk on the side of the road, facing traffic.
- Teach children to make eye contact with drivers before crossing the street and to avoid darting out or crossing between parked cars.

Costume Safety:

- Ensure costumes are fire-resistant, fit well, and are not so long that they cause tripping.
- Avoid masks or accessories that obstruct vision.

Stranger Safety:

- Only visit houses that are well-lit and familiar.
- Remind children to stay with their group and not enter a stranger's home or car.

Treat Inspection:

Inspect all treats and discard anything that is unwrapped or looks suspicious.
