NYLT Scholarship Application

About the Scholarships

In 2022, a structured financial approach began for a way to provide financial aid to Scouts to attend NYLT. Prior to 2022, money to support Scouts was raised on a year by year basis. Through memorial contributions, direct contributions, and proceeds from the Wood Badge and NYLT Annual Banquet & Auction, money was raised to establish a permeant NYLT Support Account. In October of 2025, the operating procedures for this account were read into the minutes of the Jayhawk Area Council Executive Board with the account's primary purpose (90%) to support NYLT Scholarships and secondary purpose (10%) for Youth Staff Recognition or Emergency Equipment.

Now the NYLT Support Account is primarily sustained through the annual Wood Badge and NYLT Banquet & Auction and those who believe in the impact of NYLT on a Scout.

Currently there are two ways that financial aid is provided:

1. \$50 Discount Scholarship

A \$50 reduction from the registration cost. This is automatically given to the first 28 Scouts who register for NYLT in Jayhawk Area Council.

2. Named Scholarships

Two, \$200 scholarships are awarded by application: The Dudley Havens Memorial Scholarship and the Dave Meggers Memorial Scholarship. Factors in decision making process include leadership experience, leadership potential, and financial need.

These scholarships are available to any Scout attending the NYLT course within Jayhawk Area Council. While the application is written primarily in terms for those who require financial assistance, anyone scout is welcome to apply.



Scholarship Application Process:

The following process should be used for applying for one of the NYLT Named Scholarships or requesting other financial assistance.

- 1. Identify a Scout who should attend NYLT and if they are applying for a Scholarship, have them fill out Section #1 Scout on the next page.
- 2. The Scout's Parents and Unit Leaders fill out Sections #2 and #3 together.
- 3. If financial support from the council is not a limiting factor in the Scout's ability to attend, a parent or Unit Leader should register the Scout online at www.jayhawkcouncil.org/training/nylt/
- 4. Submit a completed application to this year's Adult Leadership or the Council Office by the deadline (see below).
- 5. The NYLT Scholarship Committee will review all applications and notify applicants according to the calendar below. The comments on each application will be treated as confidential and only members of the NYLT Scholarship Committee will have access to this information.
- 6. The recipients of the Dudley Havens and Dave Meggers Memorial Scholarships will be publicly announced at the Wood Badge and NYLT Banquet.

Any late applications will only be considered on a case-by-case and financial need basis.

Applicants (Scout, Parents, and Unit Leader) will be notified by March 2 of their financial aid status.

The Dudley Havens and Dave Meggers named scholarships will be publicly presented at the annual Wood Badge and NYLT banquet on March 7.
